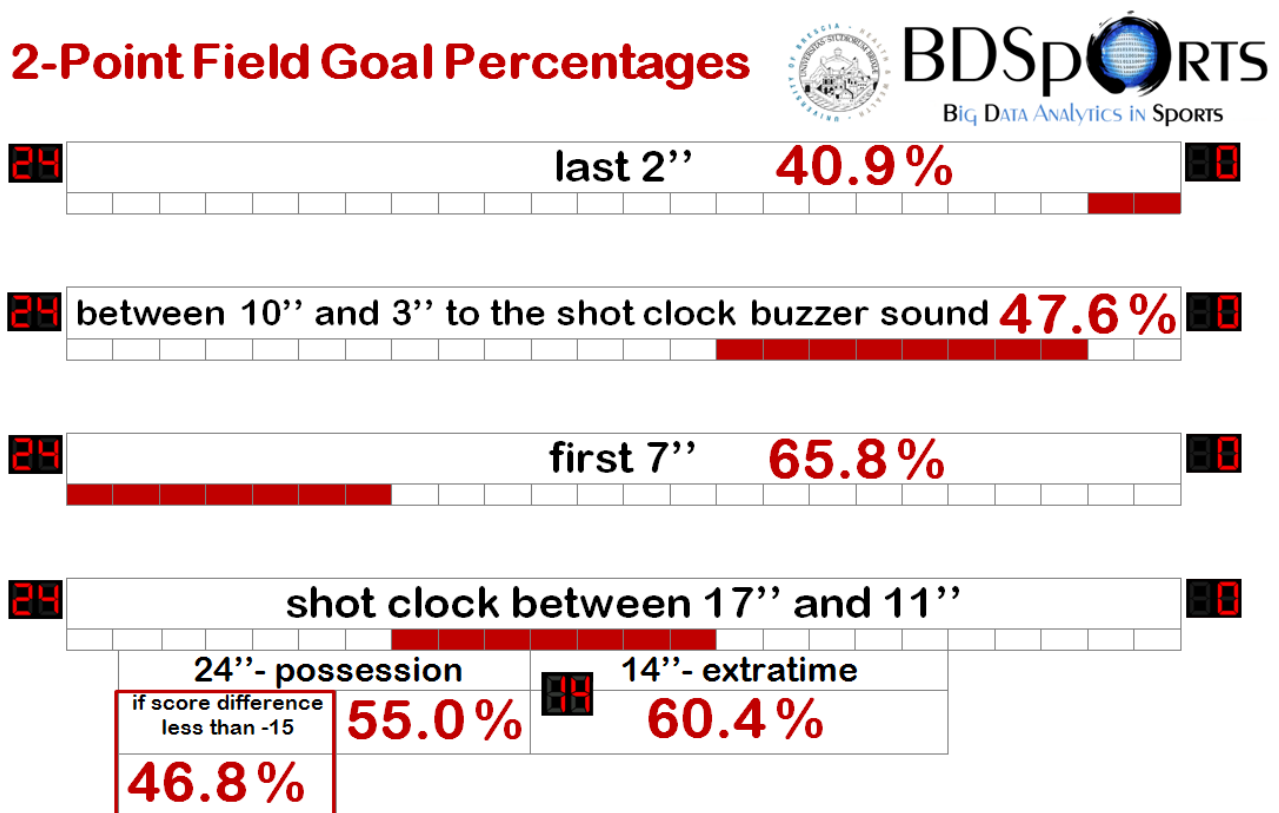


Two-Point Field Goal Percentages in different game situations

Figure 7: This graph shows the 2-point field goal percentages (2P%) computed in different game situations, with special regard to the shot clock, the type of possession and the score difference with respect to the opponent, when the shot is attempted. Specifically, shots in the first 7 seconds after earning possession have 2P% = 65.8%, late shots - last 10 seconds and last 2 seconds - have 2P% = 47.6% and 2P% = 40.9%, respectively. For the shots in the middle time (when the shot clock shows between 17 and 11 seconds), it depends on which possession the team is handling and the score difference with respect to the opponent. For 24 seconds possessions we have 2P% = 55%, but when the score difference is less than -15 points, this percentage decreases to 2P% = 46.8%. Instead, if the shot clock had previously been reset to 14 seconds, we have 2P% = 60.4%. The values are obtained by analyzing 33682 2-point field goal attempts (2015/2016 Italian A2 Championship).
